*\*The Pan-American Championships will award the continental titles. Meanwhile, the ranking for the International Cup will be determined based on the times/scores of all teams. For the "RX" race, the Knock-out stage matchups of the Pan-American Championships will be composed exclusively of teams eligible to compete for the title. At the end of this race, for the International Cup a Knock-out stage matchups will be organized in which teams from the International Cup and the top teams from the Pan-American Championships will participate.*



## Registrations fee

- **WRF members:** for their teams to compete under the conditions defined in the event notice (**free of charge**), it is necessary that the National Federation is up to date with the payment of the annual WRF membership fee.
- **Teams from countries without a WRF member:** the WRF registration fee is 75,00 Euro per team. The WRF Secretariat will send payment receipts by the end of September.

## Accreditation point

The Accreditation Office is located at [Universidad de la Frontera \(Campus Pucón\), Caupolicán n. 78, Pucón, Chile.](#)

Accreditation for delegations can be completed on

- **Tuesday, October 29<sup>th</sup>** from 9:00 to 17:00
- **Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup>** from 8:00 to 12:00.

Accreditation must be done **for the entire delegation**, not for individual teams.

Delegations will not be accredited if there are any outstanding payments. All fees must be settled before the event using traceable payment methods.

Accreditation cards will be required to access restricted areas of the event. Accreditation will be available for athletes, coaches, and other members of the delegation.

**Each athlete must ensure they have uploaded a half-length photo to their profile, clearly showing their face (passport-style photo).**

## Accommodation & Food

Free accommodation and food are available for registered and accredited teams from Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup> to Sunday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>. This doesn't apply to international teams.

Accommodation will be assigned at the accreditation.

The accommodation facilities (shared apartments) will provide beds and covers. The rooms are for 2-8 people.

Transfers from the accommodation to the competition venue and return are organized (shuttle schedules will be communicated at the accreditation).

## **Breakfast**



Breakfast is served from 7:00 to 8:00 in each accommodation area (from 31<sup>st</sup> October to 3<sup>rd</sup> November).

Anyone who does not show up during these times must arrange for their own breakfast.

Each delegation is responsible for arriving at the competition venue on time (shuttle schedules will be communicated at the accreditation).

## Insurance

All event participants must have their insurance (it is mandatory) it will be requested at the accreditation. The Organizing Committee, the hosting federation will not cover any expenses related to hospital treatment.

## Official Technical Information

The Downriver competition will be held in the “Río Trancura”.

Water temperature: 8.5°

Mandatory equipment: consult the [Sport Rules](#) published on the WRF Website. Take note that all the information concerning the sport format are defined in the Sport Rules.

The **competition river section** is closed from **Tuesday, October 29<sup>th</sup> 19:00 to the end of the competition.**

**Teams are prohibited from practicing or paddling on competition river section of the river (from the start to the arrival) outside of their designated time slots.**

## Downriver

The competition section is Class III+/IV.

The official training on 30<sup>th</sup> October will be run from the Start to the Arrival of the Downriver Section. During the downriver training session, teams are allowed to practice slalom.

Group start: Downriver start will be done in pairs (2 rafts) on the basis of the RX qualifications results (e.g. 44 teams: 1st starts with 23rd, 2nd starts with 24th and so on).





## RX Qualification, Slalom

The RX Qualifications, Downriver and Slalom will be held at “[Puente Metrenehue](#)” [Pucón, 4920000 Araucanía, Chile](#).

The competition section is Class III+.

## RX Knockout Stage

The knockout phase of the Male and Female RX, Mixed, and Para-Rafting events will take place on the Trancura River (Metrenehue section).

## Rafts

The official raft of the competition is “[Aquadesign WRF Race Competition Raft](#)”. The Federation of Chile will provide the rafts to the delegations. If the Delegations have an WRF Competition Aquadesign Competition Raft, they may use it during the event.

## Opening Ceremony Instructions

The meeting point for ALL delegations is in Pucón (Calle C. Clemente Holzapfel - Ramón Quezada) at **19:30** on Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup>.

Delegations must wear the official uniform of their countries. Participation is mandatory.

### Stage Presentation

The delegations will go up to the stage, where they will be presented to the public.

### Important note:

- **NO other flags, propaganda or messages are allowed in the parade and podium.**

## Award ceremonies Protocol

The award ceremony will take place **on November 2<sup>nd</sup> at 20:30 in Pucón Square.**

Athletes of the National Delegation **MUST** be in assembly area (close to the stage) no later than fifteen (15) minutes before the ceremony.

Only athletes who have won medals in that particular event are allowed on the podium.

Athletes should wear their **official team uniforms** and footwear must be worn (barefoot is not allowed).

Athletes may not wear hats or headgear, no sunglasses are allowed throughout the Ceremony.

### Important note:

- **Other flag, propaganda or message is NOT allowed on the podium.**

The awards ceremonies (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place for Men, Women, Mixed and Para-Rafting) will be run for all three the official disciplines (Downriver, Slalom and RX).

For the Overall Ceremonies only the Winners Team (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place) will be awarded.
